Childhelp's Children's Advocacy Center provides:

- A safe, child-focused environment where forensic interviews, medical exams and assessments of abuse take place
- Partners with the Department of Children's Services, Law Enforcement and the justice system in their efforts to convict abusers and protect children
- Offers free mental health services to children who are victims of abuse
- Provides education to the community about child sexual abuse, physical abuse and neglect

- Works to match children in the foster system with loving foster families
- Continually recruits, educates and supports foster families
- Provides case management and ongoing support and care for children in foster care and families
- Creates experiences for foster children and families to help with the process of healing from abuse and neglect
- Works to help children find the best forever home through family reunification or adoption
- Offers education to the community about child abuse, foster care, and adoption
