Childhelp Facts

Please choose one or more of the facts below to share in your video or as you are reaching out to raise funds.

Child Abuse Statistics - Nationwide:

- 5 children die every day from child abuse and neglect.
- 3 million reports of abuse are made annually.
- 80% of child abuse fatalities are children under the age of 4.
- A report of child abuse is made every 10 seconds.
- Around 80% of child maltreatment fatalities involve at least one parent as perpetrator
- 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 6 boys are victims of child sexual abuse
- 1 in 3 children experience emotional abuse
- In one study, 80% of 21-year-olds who reported childhood abuse met the criteria for at least one psychological disorder.

• Children who experience child abuse & neglect are about 9 times more likely to become involved in criminal activity.

Child Abuse Statistics - Arizona:

- In 2019, 100 children died in Arizona due to abuse and neglect. That represents 12% of all child deaths in Arizona.
- In 2019, DCS investigated cases involving more than 82,300 Arizona children.
- 75% of children who died from abuse/neglect in Arizona were less than 5 years old

Childhelp's National & Local Impact:

- Over 11 million children have been served through 62 years of Childhelp programs and services.
- Childhelp provided services to 30K children/families in Arizona last year.
- In 2020, the multidisciplinary team at Childhelp Children's Center of Arizona performed more than 2,600 forensic interviews.
- The Childhelp National Child Abuse Hotline (1-800-4-A-CHILD) 1-800-422-4453 experienced an increase in volume due to the COVID-19 pandemic, with monthly spikes as high as 46% over the previous year.
- The Childhelp National Child Abuse Hotline received 112,006 calls, texts and chats in 2020.
- In 2020, the Childhelp National Child abuse Hotline received more than 2,600 contacts from Arizona.
